

Chris was aide-de-camp to Nobel Laureate Dr. Norman E. Borlaug for more than 30 years. He joined the Sasakawa Africa Association (SAA) in 1991; formerly SAA's Director of Communications, he was appointed joint Executive Director in 2009. Following Dr. Borlaug's death in 2009, Chris worked tirelessly for SAA's objective of supporting smallholder farmers in the association's focus countries of Ethiopia, Mali, Nigeria and Uganda.

Chris' family wishes to honor and continue his work by establishing and providing initial funding for the Christopher Dowswell Scholarship Fund. Providing opportunities for women and reaching women farmers was a priority of Chris' work. Therefore, the fund will provide educational scholarships for African women in agriculture, particularly extension, in order to improve the productivity and well-being of rural women.
