ABOUT LITTLE ROCK

Little Rock is an Inclusive Early Childhood Care and Development Centre dedicated to provide a nurturing environment for vulnerable and disabled children in the Kibera Slum in Nairobi, Kenya. Little Rock is founded on the belief that all children, no matter their social and economic background, are capable of dreaming and achieving great things in life, if properly nurtured. When Little Rock opened its doors on the 1st of October 2003, 12 children attended the school. The objective was to provide Early childhood schooling for children aged 1-13 years. Today, the centre has already provided education to over 600 children who attend from Monday to Saturday. Among them are 120 special needs children (e.g. Disabled, deaf, Down syndrome). The children are taught and trained by 23 qualified P1/Early Childhood teachers and 12 careajvers.

Our Achievements

A total of 386 children have graduated and now attend different primary schools in the area. All Little Rock graduates are provided with a new uniform, desk, lunch and books enabling them to have a smoother transfer to primary school. Little Rock graduates continue to excel in their further education, many ranking top 1-5 in their respective classes. Some special needs children have developed skills to attend a normal primary school, others have acquired speech or learned to walk, this was all achieved because of our intensive occupation therapy. Little Rock has a team of 65 soccer players, our girls team plays tournaments throughout the year.

PROGRAMS AT LITTLE ROCK

Inclusive Early Childhood Education:

For children between 3-6 years.

As much as possible kids with special needs will be with the regular children, some need special care, with four separate classes based on age and needs - such as deaf children, children with celebral palsy and learning disability

Nutrition care

Feeding program.

Medical – Children with disability receive occupational, physio, hydro and speech therapy sessions according to their needs.

After school program

After School Program: All Little Rock graduates come for after school classes that begin at 4.30pm -7pm, everyday from Monday to Saturday. The after school classes are held at the Little Rock's library. The primary children come to read story books, course books for them to do their homework and get help in their weak subjects.

Co-curricular activities,

e.g. Soccer, sign language, chess

Income generating activities

Mothers with children at Little Rock get Location, materials and training to make products like aprons, bags, earrings and reusable pads, which the school sells and gives an income to the mothers.
