

DORMAA CHILDREN'S HOME INC – PROJECT ORIGINATION DOCUMENT

Dormaa Children's Home Inc was founded four years ago by Mr. Kwasi Twumasi, an Electrical Engineer with Cummins Inc in Minneapolis USA, a native of Dormaa Ahenkro of Ghana, West Africa. It is a 50 capacity children's Home to provide shelter and cater for the needs of orphans, disabled and needy children in the Dormaa area of Ghana.

The founding of the orphanage facility was necessitated by the death of Kwasi's brother-in-law from the Aids disease, followed shortly by his sister who was diagnosed with the same disease. He then asked, what happens to kids who are left as orphans when their parents die under this circumstance? What about disabled and needy children who are often left uneducated because there is no facility in this area to take care of them?

He then decided to do something about the situation for we do not have to be rich to impact the life of a child. We may not be able to help hundreds of children but we certainly can help a few.

Over the past four years, a two acre land has been purchased and a 50 capacity building structure built. The building will be roofed this year in 2013. To see work done so far please log on to our website at: www.dormaachildrenshome.org.
