Sri Arunodayam Charitable Trust provides care, protection and rehabilitation for mentally challenged children who have been abandoned by their families. Presently 115 children and adults are under our care. Yes! Many of the children who came to us have now grown into young adults.

It is overwhelming to see the growth of the children, the number of children and that of the organization. What started off as a small service at Sivananda Nagar, Kolathur has now branched into three homes. Each facility serves a specific category. Children from 0-8 years stay at the Sivananda Nagar home. Older children who are given special education, physiotherapy and those children in custodial care stay at Madanankuppam home. Adults who can be trained vocationally stay at the Kallikuppam home. Prayatna – vocational training centre, functions at Kallikuppam.

All this has happened because of kind hearted, generous people like you. Each one of you has chipped in with your own bit to build this wonderful home for the children. What their biological parents failed to do for these children, all of you have done and continue to do.

Meet our children



Yalini is 2 years old. She was abandoned at the Primary Health Centre, Jolarpet on 15.01.2013. The police rescued the child and handed over to SRDPS adoption agency. Subsequently the baby was transferred to Sri Arunodayam on 03.09.2013 by the Department of Social Welfare.

She endures severe tightness in the spinal muscles and calf

muscles, foot drop and muscles of the hands are tight. She is given exercises to stretch and strengthen the muscles. Back stretching, cross sitting, forward and backward bending exercises are also given. Now Yalini is able to sit in the CP chair, head control is achieved partially; she can stand up to half an hour while strapped in the standing frame. She is progressing well.
