Train 3000 Kibera Youth In Sport and Life Skills

We put a door on a small youth counseling office in Katwekera village in the Kibera Slums.



We improved on the involvement of girls in sports by providing a regular counseling support system.

We ran 4 environment and health workshops during the basketball and soccer training sessions. We distributed 57 soccer balls to 37 teams of boys and girls.



We provided support for teachers in schools to get closely involved in establishing local teamwork and lifeskills discussion groups. In addition, we provided distributed exercise books and stationary to 2 schools of the 37 schools currently registered.

We cleared new areas for outdoor games close to the schools. We were able to pay a monthly rent to the Nairobi West Prisons Welfare to leave their open grounds open for weekly training for 700 children





We planted 4000 trees in schools, centres, the Nairobi West Prison, and Langata Women Prison and on the Southern Bypass Road

And...best of all, we were able to feed 700 children every Saturday after play during the Soccer League, which ran from May, 16th June, 7th July and 14th July 2007, 8.30 a.m to 4.00 p.m. each day.
