



Save the frogs' day event – April 26th, 2014 – Madagascar

During 2 years, Education – Développement – Environnement Naturel NGO has a privilege to organize Save the Frogs' day event with the rest of the world.

This year, we will organize it in Isalo park where we can find the **Critically Endangered** endemic frog **Rainbow Frog** (*Scaphiophryne gottlebei*) by IUCN.

Our theme is: “**involve children in environment protection through a valuable practice in favor of ecosystem**”.

What activities?

Reforestation and bio green-gardener activities will be organized with the school of Andriamanero.

- As you can find in this URL <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=D6Ss6gtEFoU>, the periphery of the park needs an urgent reforestation.
- The increasing environment degradation leads to a prolonged drought - consequently to the diminution of agriculture product, we will organize a bio green-gardener for the school.

Why these activities?

- With the reforestation, we would like to restore the periphery of the park where most of habitats of the frogs were found.
- The bio-green gardener will help us to train students on how to create and use a local bio-fertilizer and bio-pesticide in order to protect the habitat of the frogs and the whole environment. In addition, it will provide them food for their future school canteen.

Our hope is that they replicate it at home in order to sensitize local community for environment protection and help their families to struggle with food insecurity.

Timeline

Our event will be during 2 days:

- April 25th, reforestation in the periphery of the park
- April 26th, establishment of bio-green gardener surrounding the school
