- \$76** supplies 200 books -- enough for two classes
- \$304** supplies 800 books -- enough for a school library
- \$2,375** supplies 6,250 books -- enough for five schools
- \$9,000** supplies a full container of 35,000 books -- enough for 20 schools

Cash Gifts

Your cash, check, or credit card gift to Books For Africa can be designated for a specific program or directed to where the need is greatest. All gifts are tax deductible, as specified by law. For your convenience, gifts by credit card can be made directly online at www.booksforafrica.org

Matching Gifts

Check with your employer about matching gifts. Many companies match employee donations dollar for dollar to the charity of the employee's choice.

Wills and Other Planned Gifts

Books For Africa can be named a beneficiary in your will and receive other deferred gifts such as life insurance. These gifts are not subject to estate taxes.

Gifts of Appreciated Stock

Books For Africa and you can benefit from gifts of stock (provided you have held the stock for 18 months or longer). You can eliminate capital gains taxes, avoid income tax on the gifted stock, and receive tax deductions for the full value of the stock.

Books For Africa relies on volunteers to help sort and pack books, plan special events, produce publications, raise funds, and speak to groups. Put your special skills to work!

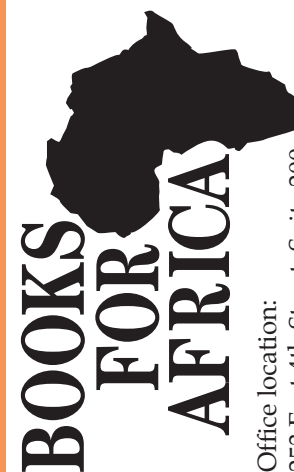

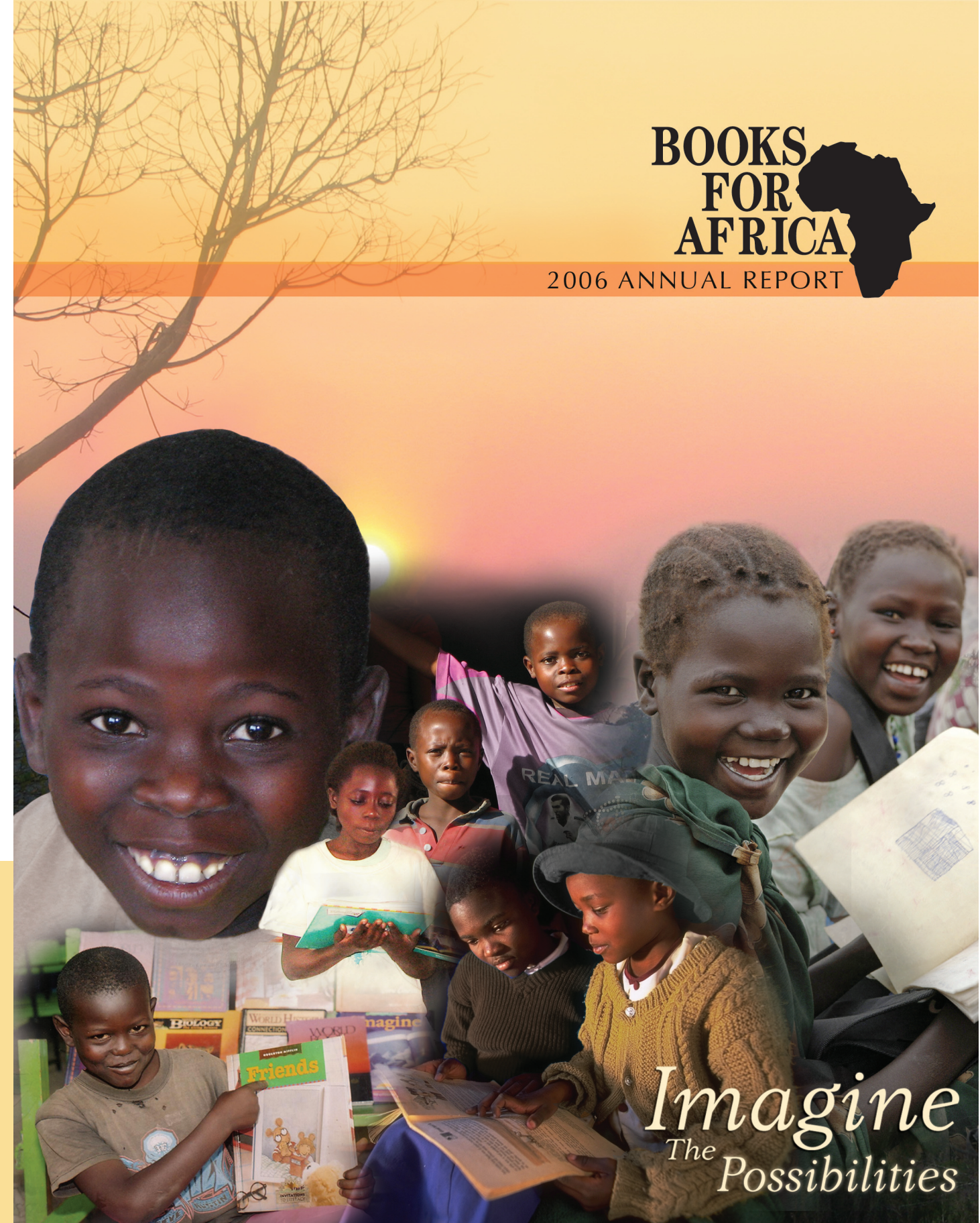
