Meet One of Our Volunteers in San Francisco, Argentina: Daniela Taverna



Name: Daniela Alejandra Taverna Occupation: High school teacher in San Francisco, Argentina, with specialization in Accounting and Law.

"I decided to collaborate with VISIONAR because I thought it would be good experience," said Daniela.

"I often see students in their senior year of high school who either have not decided what to study if go to college or don't consider themselves capable of going to college. VISIONAR gives me the opportunity to encourage my students to change their attitude and to prepare their future."

Since December 2009, Daniela has assisted with VISIONAR's recruitment by presenting the program and applications to local high schools, and by interviewing candidates in their home environment. "The experience was wonderful," commented Daniela. Thanks to her thorough interview reports, our Board of Directors was able to identify the candidates most deserving of a VISIONAR scholarship.

VISIONAR SCHOLARS COMMUNITY SERVICE: TUTORING AT-RISK HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Besides maintaining high grades, VISIONAR students are required to dedicate 4 hours a month to community service.

To fulfill this second requirement, Graciela (VISIONAR's coordinator) and the five scholarship recipients started a program that provides one-on-one tutoring to at-risk high school students at Colegio Nacional San Martín in San Francisco, Argentina.

VISIONAR students set up office hours at the school, where students can come by and ask for help in the areas of expertise of each VISIONAR student. Pamela is helping with English lessons, Maxi, Emi and Angela help with

math, Maxi also helps with Physics, and Gastón helps with biology.

Maxi commented that one of the students he is helping is very smart, but unmotivated. So besides explaining math concepts, Maxi and the other VISIONAR students are fulfilling a much higher role of inspiring and guiding their younger counterparts.

VISIONAR and Asociación Atrapasueños are very grateful to Colegio Nacional San Martín and to principal Gabriela Vastik for giving our students the opportunity to contribute through this tutoring program and to inspire other students.
