We have been operating since January 2006, and we currently serve 350 farm families (1,500 children). Our target is to change the lives of 30,000 families (150,000 children) within five years, and scale at a 50-100% growth rate thereafter. One Acre Fund is one of the most externally-validated social start-ups of 2006, earning grants from the highly competitive Echoing Green and Draper Richards Foundations, and winning first place at the Stanford and Yale social venture competitions.
