

Clean water and equipment for health clinic

Summary

This project will provide clean water to a Rehabilitation Treatment Centre in Laos, and buy basic medical equipment and supplies. The clinic serves over 1000 patients each month suffering with serious health problems.

The center serves in patients and out patients.

The Rehabilitation Treatment Centre in Laos provides free health checks to patients, and provides low cost alternative treatments to in-patients and out-patients suffering with disease and sickness. Many people in Laos cannot afford to receive medical attention in state hospitals. Hospitals are also often ill equipped to treat serious illnesses. The centre helps patients who find themselves without any other means of obtaining medical attention.

The clinic is based in a beautiful, and remote, part of Laos. The location is very beneficial to healing. The center does not have access to an electricity supply, and uses a generator for less than four hours a day and electricity generated through bio-gas.

There is no running water at the centre and they desperately need a filtration system for clean drinking water. The water will also be used for cooking and brewing herbal remedies.

Planned activities

- We will install a water filtration system to provide clean drinking water to patients suffering with serious sickness and disease.
- We will fund much need medical equipment and medicines to treat patients.
- We will fund research into traditional and herbal medicines.
- A volunteer from the USA will be assisting research into medicines.
