own children, as women invest more of their income in their families than men do. Yet, many barriers to education for girls remain. Once women began to graduate from institutions of higher education, there steadily developed also a stronger academic stream of schooling, and the teacher training of women in larger numbers, principally to provide primary education. While it was not common for women to enroll as students in formal classes, it was common for women to attend informal lectures and study sessions. There were no legal restrictions on female education.
