Community Programs:

DoveLewis is proud to offer several programs to the community made possible by our generous donors.

Financial Assistance Programs:

The Velvet Assistance Fund provides financial assistance for qualifying low-income clients experiencing a pet emergency. The **Charlie Fund** is dedicated to giving abused animals the emergency care and protection they so desperately need.

Blood Bank Program: Each year, the donor-based DoveLewis Blood Bank provides enough blood and plasma for more than 500 transfusions for dogs and cats in the Northwest and beyond.

Portland Area Canine Therapy Teams (PACTT) Program: A special partnership between DoveLewis and Guide Dogs for the Blind brings animal-assisted therapy to the local community in a variety of settings, including homeless shelters, hospitals, assisted-living facilities, schools and libraries.

Stray Animal & Wildlife Program: DoveLewis never turns away an injured or ill stray animal or wildlife. This program offers care for the increasing number of sick and injured stray and wildlife animals brought to the hospital 24 hours a day.

Pet Loss Support Program: DoveLewis offers free resources for people who have loved and lost their beloved pets. Our services include pet loss support group meetings, memorial art therapy workshops and an annual Service of Remembrance event. Also as a part of this program, the My Pet Remembrance Journal is given to families who lose a pet at DoveLewis.

Loacker Golden Education Program: As an accredited teaching hospital, DoveLewis' commitment to educating the community is made possible by the Loacker Golden Education Program. DoveLewis offers regular continuing education lectures, an annual conference, internships, externships and atdove.org, a video-based educational website for all types of veterinary professionals. Pet first aid workshops are also offered to the public regularly.
