

REBUILD IN HAITI

In response to the devastating earthquake of January 12, 2010, REBUILD Globally was established to address two critical issues:

- 1) unemployment
- 2) pollution—particularly waste tires, which are traditionally burned as means of elimination. By establishing a workforce development program, REBUILD is taking a three-pronged approach to rebuilding Haiti.



EMPLOYMENT

By offering living wage employment, REBUILD increases opportunities for earthquake survivors in Haiti to become self-sufficient.

EDUCATION

REBUILD offers English and business classes on site and provides opportunities to help vulnerable populations attend school.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

REBUILD initiates apprenticeship opportunities, programs for street boys & Haitian led partnerships as a catalyst for community change.

REBUILD Globally (RG) is a tax exempt 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, based in Orlando, FL operating in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. Our mission is to improve the quality of life and create healthier environments for people in distressed communities by using new and innovative techniques that promote recycling, eco-friendly development, gainful employment, agriculture and education.

WHAT WE DO

RG collaborates with Haitian nationals to produce eco-friendly, and locally crafted products. The RG socially-conscious business model trains, employs and equips Haitians to produce sandals and other repurposed merchandise for sale around the globe. Our research-based initiatives focus on long term community development and creating self sustaining income-generating opportunities.



WHO WE ARE

LIVELIHOODS: RG employs Haitians at living-wages, teaches management & business skills and removes all barriers possible for staff to thrive.

STREET CHILDREN: RG provides basic needs & medical care to kids living on the street and provides opportunities for school



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT RG offers an apprenticeship program for students to **Earn.**

Learn. Succeed. Community gardens and sandal donations are also available to those in need.

REBUILDERS

REBUILDERS are the first product designed by our Haitian artisans.

We collect abandoned tires from the streets & repurpose



them into eco-friendly, locally crafted sandals. In addition to our staff, vulnerable youth are referred to our apprenticeship program. Students are trained in sandal and bag making (skills they can use for future employment.) In return, RG pays all school fees so they received a proper education. RG sells sandals internationally and has a sandal donation program for local orphanages. By purchase sandals you are contributing to the long term recovery of Haiti.
