TARGET AREA BACKGROUND AND PROBLEMS:-

The coastal villages are frequently affects by cyclones and floods 2- 8 times normally and severely 2 times in every year, the people living coastal fishing and dalit communities lost their livelihoods and damage of livelihood sources. women lost their regular livelihoods sources of fishing and agriculture, they need alternative livelihood sources to support their family wellbeing.

The school dropout rate is high in coastal villages, very severe in the case of girls, the girls education is highly neglected by parents and violate the rights of the girl children. Due to the poverty and in access to the educational institutions, girl children are forced in to child labour and child marriages.

NEED OF THE PROGRAM:-

The women need alternative livelihood sources to support their family wellbeing. This project will address long term sustainable livelihood solutions through skill training on micro enterprises leaf plate making, dress making, pickle making for 150 women to earn additional income for their families.

The adolescent girls needs life skills, sex education and vocational trainings like sewing, dress making, computers to 150 adolescent girls to improve the quality of life and social dignity
