LifeSpring Foundation is a newly launched foundation with a mission to give very low-income women in India access to high quality childbirth. The Foundation has been created by LifeSpring Hospital, a private chain of hospitals that serve low-income women with high quality maternal healthcare at affordable prices.

LifeSpring Foundation serves women living below the poverty line, who desire an institutional delivery but otherwise lack access to quality care.

These women have no other option but to deliver their baby at home, or go to an under-resourced government hospital. It is these women who are most vulnerable to complications during childbirth, as they are less likely to visit an obstetrician for regular antenatal check-ups during their pregnancy. According to Human Rights Watch, 75% of Indian maternal deaths are preventable with access to basic antenatal care and a trained obstetrician during childbirth.



For \$130, you can sponsor a complete pregnancy package, including antenatal care, delivery, and post-natal care:

- \$80 delivery with skilled obstetrician
- \$35 antenatal care, including doctor's visits, up to 3 ultrasound scans, and lab tests
- \$15 emergency insurance fund for any delivery complications (if unused, this amount will go towards other deliveries)

Through its Sponsoring Births program, LifeSpring Foundation accepts donations from around the world to sponsor a safe pregnancy and delivery for these women. For a flat price of \$130, each sponsored woman will be given a complete package consisting of: all antenatal care doctor consultations; up to 3 ultrasound scans; lab tests (including HIV test); a normal delivery or caesarian delivery (if medically necessary); and one month of post-natal care (including a consultation with a pediatrician).

Alter the way that these women experience a basic human right: To have a safe, healthy and dignified childbirth. Change how a baby comes into our world. Sponsor a delivery.
