The story of one Krantikaari...

18-year-old Shweta arrived at Kranti last year. We first addressed her health needs, TB and psychotherapy, then she started dance, guitar, photography and swimming classes. Through Kranti, she visited sex workers' unions, taught gender workshops in a Kashmir school, and went trekking in the Himalayas. Shweta then designed and implemented an empowerment program for Nepali teens at risk for trafficking. In 2012, Shweta spoke at five conferences, was accepted to Semester at Sea and applied to American University.



In order to do this, Kranti wants to build a permanent home that will house 25 girls as well as Kranti's for-profit ventures: a coffeeshop, art/bookstore and theatre program. To make this possible, Kranti wants to build a permanent home that will accommodate at least 25 girls to begin with and also have space for Kranti's for-profit ventures, which will include a coffeeshop, art/bookstore and theatre program. To make this possible, we are seeking land, a flat, an old building, or a combination thereof, in Mumbai's suburbs.



Why does Kranti need its own home?

In the words of Shweta...

Kranti needs a home where the Revolutionaries feel free, safe and supported. A place where people respect us: our past, our present and the future we are trying to build.

In our rented flat, the neighbors find any excuse to complain about us and ask us to leave. Why? Because we are not rich enough, we don't speak enough English, eve-teased, we are too dark-skinned. We are harassed, subject to verbal abuse on the streets, and many of us come home crying.

We want to build a home and school in a community where the Revolutionaries feel safe. We want to build a sustainable organization where we don't have to worry about grants and donations, where Revolutionaries can work and earn. Where we can learn from our pasts and work towards our futures!
