They started their soap making business in March of 2010 with her first loan of \$50 from PMI.

They then produced 2 boxes of soap per day to sell in their community.

Savon Mileto (Mileto Soap) is what they named their product. In May 2010, two months later, they took a second loan for \$100. In September they took their third loan for \$200!
