Action - The staff of the Future Society leads



VOLUNTEERS

We screen volunteers thoroughly, both in terms of safety and suitability for mentoring. Volunteers complete a written application, a in-person interview, and provide references.

We find the most suitable





people and helping them foster positive relationships in their lives, rather than simply achieving good grades or staying out of trouble. Young people are encouraged to make decisions about activities, and volunteers refrain from being too judgmental or "preachy". They view their role as a trusted friend rather than as a teacher.

ACTIVITIES



Our activities center on offering young people the opportunity to participate in outdoor recreational outlets like horseback riding, camping, kayaking and rock climbing at minimal cost. We also have developed a series of organized group activities to be conducted in local parks that will be offered free of charge.
