Update on AMDA's International Scholarship

AMDA has been awarding the scholarship to the high school students living in Tohoku region, where the life have been impacted by the March 11th Disasters. Each student receives 15,000 yen / month (180,000 yen/year) until she/he graduates high school.

In 2011, 84 students received this scholarship, and 101 students for 2012. We are happy to announce that 47 students graduated from their high schools in March, 2013 to make their new step forward. We are in the process of choosing more scholarship recipients for this year.
