DID YOU KNOW? Most of our waste is dumped on landfills due to which the area needed for landfills has increased by 20,000% in the last 50 yrs.



- providing households and larger organisations with effective, efficient, compact, modular and easy-to-monitor, decentralised multi-chamber vermicompost bins


Vermpet's Bin – Stats :

Implementation

Floor area covered per bin = 12 inches X 10 inches Waste composted per month per bin = 20-30 kgs Vermicompost generated per month per bin = 15-20 kgs Species of worm used in the bin = E.Fetida Bedding = Vermicompost, Cow-dunk (first feed), paper

Approach Schools and RWAs : Workshop and demonstrations Set up vermicomposting clubs and vermpet's bins at the unit
