He has persuaded the Karnataka State Small Scale Development Council to help him get land at a subsidized price to start his business. But he doesn't have the finance...




Muniraju's application for a loan has been rejected, because he lacks collateral. His house is not in his name, he rents it and it cannot be used as collateral. He owns no other property.
