## 29<sup>TH</sup> CANDLELIGHT MARCH MEMORIAL NARRATIVE REPORT

### **1.EVENT DESCRIPTION**

**Rwanda-Village Concept Project** (RVCP) is an interdisciplinary organization run by volunteers' students of different nationalities in close cooperation with local communities in Southern Province of Rwanda.

It is linked to other Village Concept Projects worldwide through the International Association of Village Concept Projects. Its main goal is the improvement of living conditions in underprivileged communities through increased self-reliance, and responsibility as well as capacity development for students.

RVCP was formed in May 2000 have been developed from the Community Health Project in Huye District, Rwanda". The scheme was initiated through the Medical Students Association of Rwanda and the International Federation of Medical Students' Association in partnership with medical students from the National University of Rwanda.

At the moment RVCP is running five Programs and supports two initiatives:

#### **PROGRAMS**

- HIV/AIDS Awareness, reproductive health and Family Planning
- Malaria Prevention
- Hygiene, Water and Sanitation
- HIV and Gender Empowerment
- Income Generation

#### **INITIATIVES**

- Let The Little Children Come to Me (LLCCM) Orphan Support Center
- Huye Health Center Capacity Development Initiatives

The participation of the community is an essential aspect in implementing the projects and, more generally, in providing basic health care. The key actors are people from the community. Through this they are empowered, gaining greater self-reliance and more active responsibilities additionally improving their own health. They are therefore involved in all stages of the Projects; from initial planning through to the evaluation.

The Candlelight Memorial occurs on the third Sunday of May, lead by volunteer coordinators who host memorials for their communities worldwide. Last year in 2011 it was 28<sup>th</sup> year internationally, and organized by Rwanda Village Concept Project for the fifth time in Huye, the candle light memorial 2011 had the official theme "Touching lives..." with the general objective of fight against HIV remembrance all those who have been affected by HIV pandemic and was commemorated worldwide on the Sunday, May 15<sup>th</sup> 2011.

In this year of 2012, it was the sixth time that Rwanda Village Concept Project-RVCP conducted the Candlelight March Memorial postponed from the third Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> May to **27<sup>th</sup> May 2011** at HUYE district. The theme for the 2012 Candlelight Memorial is "**Promoting Health and Dignity Together**".



## 2. OBJECTIVES OF CANDLELIGHT MARCH MEMORIAL

- ✓ Honor those affected by HIV/AIDS in order to give a hope for people living with HIV/AIDs.
- ✓ Community education on HIV/AIDS basics (Transmission, Prevention and Treatment) promote Voluntary Counseling and Testing of HIV
- ✓ Address the needs of people living with HIV/AIDS, calling for more actions to support them and making anti retroviral accessible to as many people as possible
- ✓ Call for more action to help children infected and/or orphaned by HIV/AIDS
- ✓ Call for greater strategies and actions to help strengthen preventative measures promoting responsible behavior amongst youth and the general community
- ✓ Fight against the stigma and discrimination associated with the AIDS pandemic.

### 3. SCHEDULE AND ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT

After five successive successful candlelight march memorial in Huye, **Rwanda Village Concept Project** (www.rwanda-vcp.org; www.rvcp.weebly.com) has been selected for the sixth time by **Global Health Council** (www.globalhealth.org) among other organizations to host this year the candlelight march memorial in Huye District, Southern province in Rwanda. The march was carried out about 40 minutes in the town of Huye starting from Huye Multi-purpose room "Salle polyvalente", passing near the main business center in Huye (HUYE Main Market) and ending at Huye Multi-purpose room "Salle polyvalente" where another AIDS campaign took place composed of messages, drama, poems, dances,

etc. performed by patients living with HIV/AIDS , Anti HIV/AIDS Youth Clubs, Groups from rural areas, Secondary schools in Huye District and students of the National University of Rwanda. The aim was to educate on HIV/AIDS, to call all people to take action in the fight against HIV/AIDS and to raise awareness on needs of people affected by HIV/AIDS. During that community mobilization and education we provided condom boxes for condom distribution.
