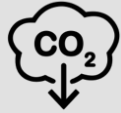

CONSERVATION AGREEMENTS

AERF launched India's first incentive-based forest conservation initiative to avoid deforestation and conserve biodiversity in 2008 in the northern Western Ghats and today we have brought more than 7500 acres of forest land under conservation management till year 2028.

By the year 2025, we aim to bring at least 15000 acres of prime forest land under conservation agreements till the year 2040!

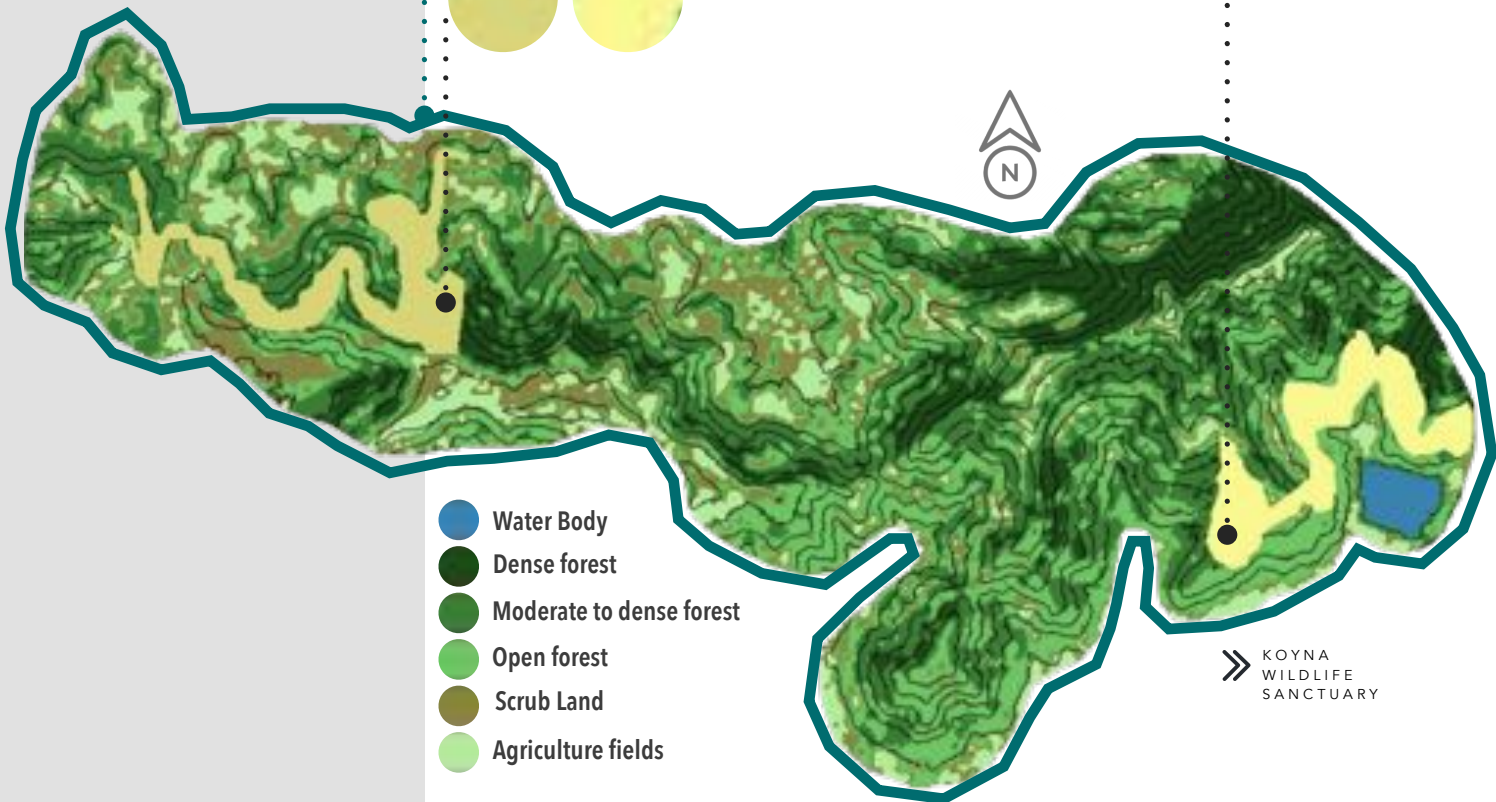
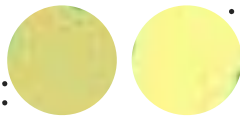
