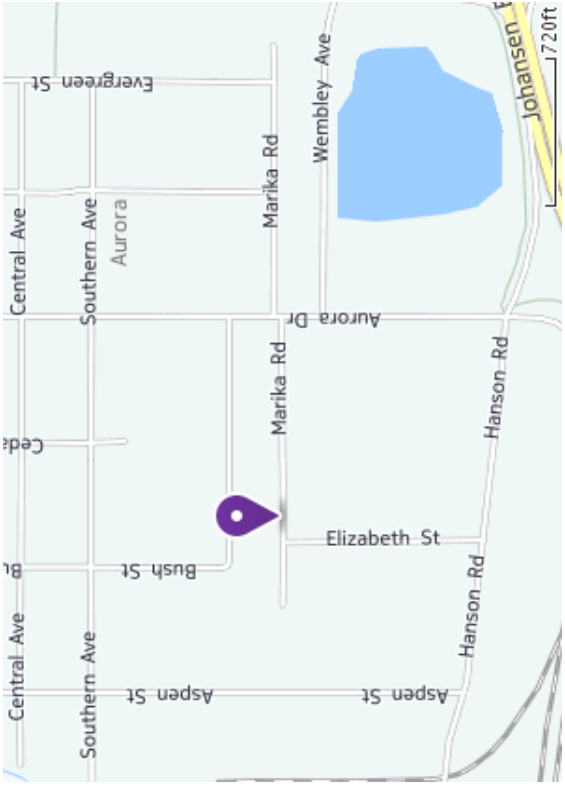
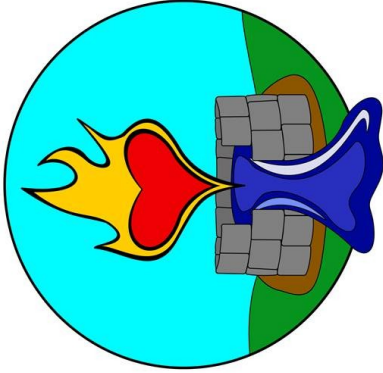


Joel's Place mission is to give creative, adventurous, adrenalin seeking youth a good, positive outlet for their energy.

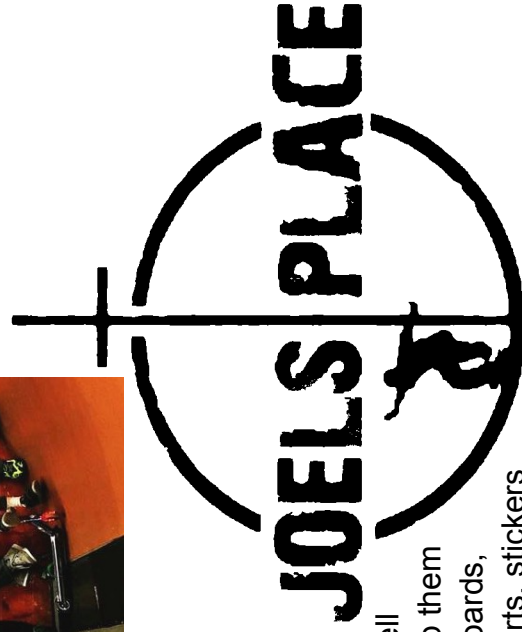
