

# Early Diagnosis of CANCER can Save a Child's Life

**Look out for these early warning signs and alert your nearest health centre if your child has any one of these symptoms**

● **Enlarged head.**

● **Difficulty balancing.**

● **Lumps.**

(Abnormal lump or lumps on the body)

● **Headaches.**

(Often and with early morning vomiting)

● **Swelling.**

(Unusual swelling or abdominal mass)

● **Personality change.**

(Change in behaviour or development)

● **Listlessness.**

(A high temperature that won't come down, sudden weight loss, poor appetite)

● **Aching bones.**

(Aching bones, joints or back, or fractures that happen easily)

● **Pallor.**

(A pale face especially if accompanied by listlessness, a high temperature or unexplained bruising)

● **Changes in the eye or vision.**

(White spot in the pupil, sudden squinting, bulging eyeball, blindness)

● **Unexplained bruising or bleeding.**

(Persistent bleeding or development of purple marks indicating bleeding beneath the skin)
