A) SUMMARY OF INSPIRED2BECOME

A1) WHO?

Inspired2Become (I2B) is a non-profit organisation that does youth develop. I2B was founded in 2010 by two brothers who are both athletes: Chris and Fanie van der Merwe. In 2016 speech therapist, Jami van der Merwe, joined the team as administrative officer and also started an educational therapy program in a developing area.

Fanie van der Merwe:

- *Two times Paralympics gold medallist and world record holder in the 100m and 200m in 2008, Beijing. Paralympic Gold medallist and world record holder in 100m in 2012, London*
- Degree in BA Sport Science (University of Stellenbosch)
- Level 2 ASA coaching diploma
- **Focusses on athletics for youth with disabilities**

Chris van der Merwe:

- *Internationally qualified pro-rollerblader at the Amateur World Championships in USA in 2008. Asian X Games top 10 competitor 2008-2013*
- Degree in BCom Communication Management (University of Pretoria)
- Post-grad diploma in Copywriting (AAA School of Advertising)
- **Focusses on alternative action sports i.e. skateboarding, rollerblading, skimboarding**

Jami van der Merwe:

- Degree in B Speech, Language and Hearing Therapy (University of Stellenbosch)
- Qualified Phono-Graphix Therapist (Read for Africa)
- Advance Certificate in Photography
- **Focusses on Educational Therapy, admin and media**

A2) WHY?

There are many different youth groups in South Africa. Some are less main stream and gets overlooked very easily. These groups feel left out many times and do not believe that they have a great future with many possibilities. By meeting these groups where they are at, they can find hope and opportunities. These future generations can be inspired to make good choices and to believe that there is a great future for their lives.

A3) HOW? (Mission)

To focus on youth who gets over-looked many times and to inspire them, through positive role modeling, relationship building, coaching sport, therapy, mentoring life skills and creating opportunities and leadership/coach development.

A4) WHO's INVOLVED?

Inspired2Become's current Projects are as follows (in partnership with churches, municipalities, schools & other organizations):

- Athletics for people with disabilities – schools and individuals (3 weekly clubs)
Individual athletes, as well as athletes from Alta du Toit School and Pioneer School for the Blind.
- Alternative action sports – sport clubs (11 weekly clubs)
I2B Cloetesville Skate club, I2B Belhar Skate club, I2B Kleinvlei Skate club, I2B Bonteheuwel Skate club, I2B Macassar Skate club, I2B Strand Skate club, I2B Pebbles skate club, I2B Bright Lights Skate club, I2B Somerset West Skate club, I2B Gordon's Bay Skimboarding club, I2B Strand Skimboarding club.
- Educational therapy - Raithby Primary School
I2B educational therapy given weekly to foundation phase learners from Raithby Primary school. The focus is on literacy and language skills.

**I2B also provides equipment, does skate park development in communities and once off events and tours.*

C) MILESTONES AND PROJECT TIMELINES (2010 – 2016)

2010

- *Inspired2Become (I2B): Youth Development through Sport*
- I2B was started by brothers, Chris & Fanie van der Merwe.
- Both felt to use the sports they love to impact the youth of SA.
- Chris started coaching Action Sports (rollerblading, skateboarding, skimboarding); Fanie started coaching Atheletics for Youth with Disabilities
- They incorporated Life Skills lessons (based on Biblical Principles) into their sport club sessions.

2011

- Chris Weekly Action Sports Clubs: Cloeteville, Stellenbosch (included Kayamandi), Kleinvlei, Bonteheuwel
- Fanie Weekly Athletics Clubs (part time): Pioneers School for the Blind & Alta du Toit School
- I2B's first outreach program was launched in the beginning of 2011 in Cloeteville. I2B built wooden skate ramps for Cloetevilles and afterwards they held a competition in collaboration with Stellenbosch Municipality and Mayor, Conrad Sidego.
- I2B partnered with local NGO, Pebbles Project: Started giving skateboarding and rollerblading lessons at the skatepark in Stellenbosch.
- One of the I2B athletes, Candy Pretorius, participated in the Regional Special Olympics and won both the 100m and 200m for women u/21. Another I2B athlete, Denswill Maans, was chosen for the IPSA games and also won silver and gold at the IBSA Games in America.
- Inspired2Become featured on "Keep it Real" on SABC2.

2012

- I2B supported and helped raise funds for athlete, Jan Nehro, and his guide, Duane Fortuin, to take part in the London 2012 Paralympics.
- Four I2B athletes competed at Zone 6 - an international race in Zambia. Marco van der Linde received silver for the 800m T13 and Denswill Maans received bronze for 100m T12. Fanie was also a guide for one of the Blind athletes at this competition.
- New I2B weekly action sports clubs started in Belhar, Strand and Gordons Bay.
- I2B partnered with Uneek Mvmnt and featured on the SABC1 program, "Play Your Part" (focus was on the Bonteheuwel skate club).

2013

- I2B athlete, Ruan van Rooyen, was nominated as the junior athlete of the year for making A qualification standards at World Champs.
- I2B athlete, Denswill Maans, was selected to participate at the World Championships in France.
- I2B built new ramps for the skatepark in Strand.
- I2B Skatepark moved from Stellenbosch to Somerset West and the park got a new cement layer.
- Chris & Fanie became part of the International Sports Coalition (ISC) and joined the ISC in Florida (US) to put together free resources for sport ministries.

2014

- I2B received an Unashamedly Ethical award for ethics in sport.
- Fanie received a Presidential Award for Athletics.
- Pebbles Project and Bright Lights Safe House partnered with I2B - the children started visiting the I2B Skatepark in Somerset West once a week.
- I2B partnered with The Mega Sports Classic in Bredasdorp.
- I2B started a weekly action sports club in Macassar.

2015

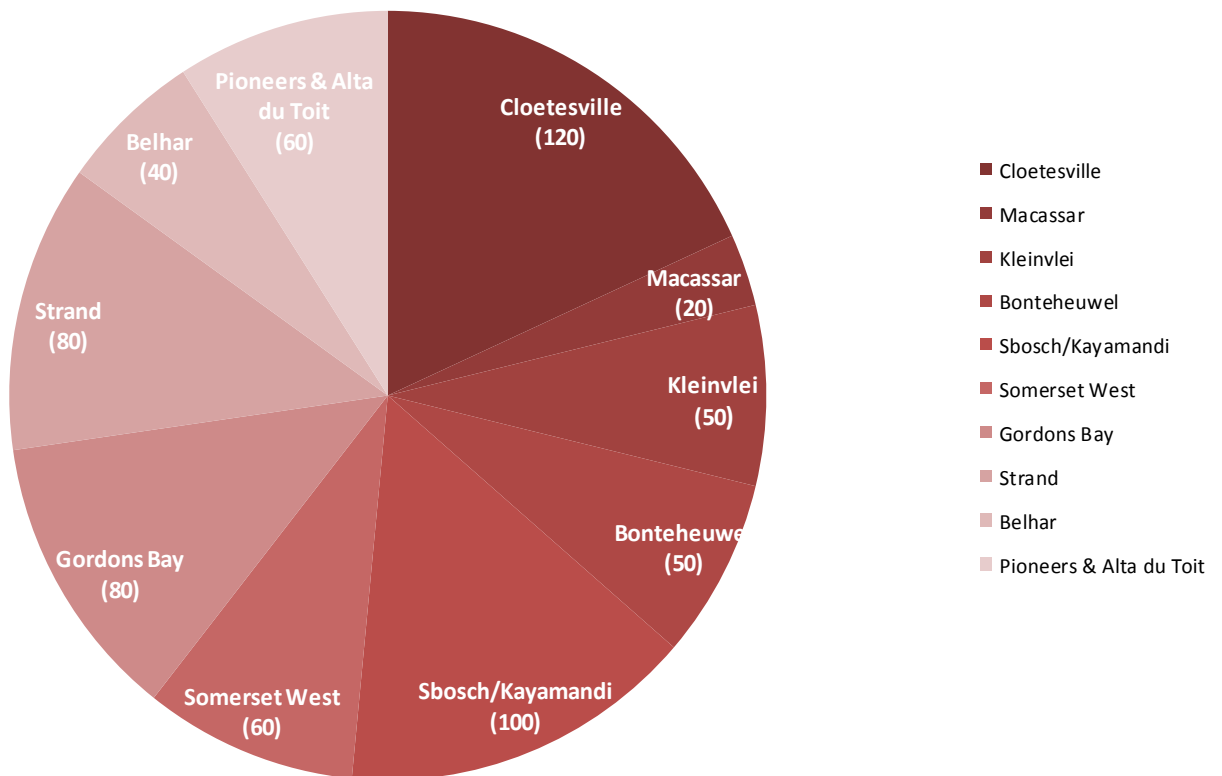
- Fanie shared his story and his role at Inspired2Become in the "Juig" magazine.

- I2B set up ramps at the CS Skatepark in Paarl.

2016

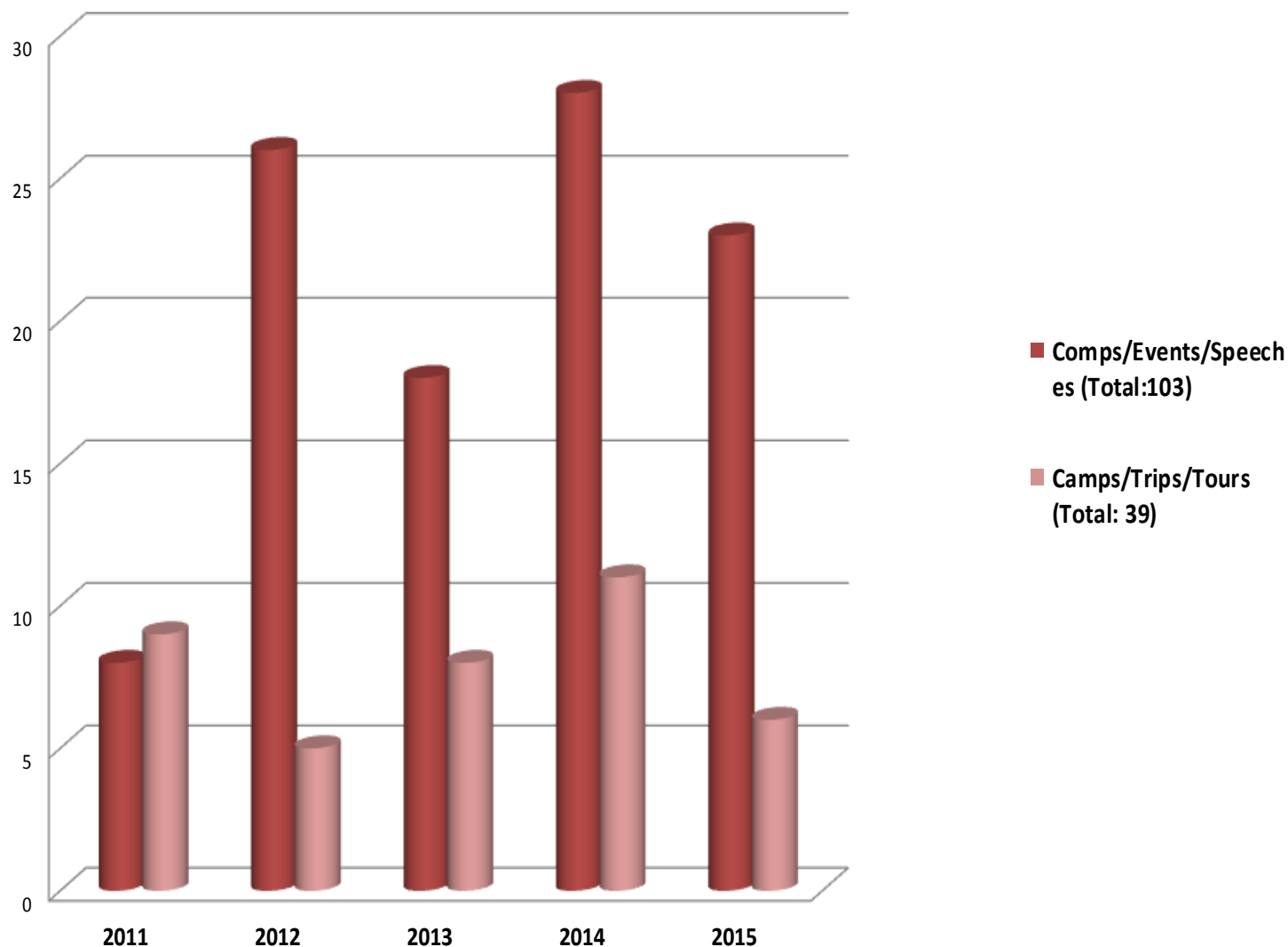
- Inspired2Become changed its name from "Youth Development through Sport" to "Youth Development" in general.
