Did You Know? Chimpanzees feed on a variety of plants, insects, meat and fruit. They even help to disperse fruit seeds in their dung.

You can protect primates by:

- 1. Planting trees: Plant trees near your home for harvesting wood, leaving forest trees for animals to use for food and shelter.
- 2. Observing: Learn about the animals around you by quietly watching them and sharing what you learn.
- Picking up rubbish: Pick up any rubbish near the forest and near your home to maintain a healthy environment for people and animals.
- 4. Contacting authorities: If you see a primate being harmed, sold or kept as a pet, notify authorities or a nearby PASA sanctuary. Remember, wild animals never make good pets!
