

Wheelchairs and White canes for Asia 2012

Needs of problem:

China and Nepal are still caught up in nature disaster/ war or still had victims of disaster/ war who had yet to be helped. In these countries, other than disabilities due to sicknesses or ages, many people became disabled due to landmines, explosive remnants of war, or sickness after nature disaster.

Their disabilities have caused them to be withdrawn from the society, and in times, poverty, medical, employment, and other related challenges occurred. They become heavy-reliance towards their families for financial and other supports. Eventually, the families and communities are affected as they have to take care of the disabled.

Although counseling, vocation training and other social assistance are available, the distance from home to help remain impossible to them. Hence, in order to encourage the disabled to return to society and become self-reliance once again, the first step is to assist their mobility.

With suitable assistive devices like wheelchairs, one can increase their mobility and allow social help within their reach.

Action Plan

Eden always receives requests for assistive devices. However, professional assessment will first be conducted to ensure the suitability of the assistive devices. If we are confidence that the device is suitable for the community, then the needed devices will be produced from our selected factories, of which we can ensure the devices' quality and suitability.

The new devices will then be delivered to the people in needs by our staff and/or our partners. Instruction will be given to the people with disabilities on how to use the devices correctly. Follow-up evaluation will be conducted by our local partners, whom will then evaluate other future possible social assistance.

Evaluation

- Short-term: 130 disabled can increase their mobility within their home.
- Mid-term: At least 80% of which will back to the streets in their communities.
- Long-term: In the long run, they can receive other social support, vocation training and employment, so as to enhance their financial status and living condition.

• History:

Ms. Liu Hsia (1942~2003), the late wheelchair writer who suffered from rheumatic arthritis, had witnessed the discrimination against people with disabilities in Taiwan through her life. Having a deep compassion for the people with disabilities, Ms Liu claimed on the promise of God and donated her royalties as seed fund to build a place, just like the Garden of Eden, where the disabled can truly belong and be loved. Her dream began to unfold when she was joined by a group of Christians who shared the same vision to bring people with disabilities out of their isolation. On December 1, 1982, Eden Social Welfare Foundation was founded.

It's our objectives to provide "comprehensive human care" for people for all ages. Services include early childhood intervention, vocational training, employment counseling, rehabilitation, new immigrant consultation, long-term daily care, and community redevelopment for disaster victims. Every effort is put together to ensure that our mission is carried on.

In addition to serving people with disabilities in Taiwan, Eden also closely linked to the development of disability rights in Taiwan. We have been actively advocating for the rights of people with disabilities in Taiwan by lobbying for the amendments of "Physically and Mentally Disabled Citizens Protection Act", raising public awareness to the need of special education, supporting the legislation of the "Act for Social Workers", and advocating for a professional certification system for social workers.

Eden also joins international aid efforts by actively participating in international relief and donation in 26 nations like Afghanistan, Bolivia, Cambodia, China, El Salvador, Haiti, India, Iraq, Japan, Jordan, Korea, Kosovo, Laos, Malawi, Malaysia, Myanmar, Mozambique, Nepal, Nicaragua, Pakistan, Paraguay, Philippines, Russia, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Vietnam and etc. We has also established overseas branch offices and centers in Malaysia, Vietnam and China.

In these 30 years, from being the voice of the physically and mentally disabled and fighting for their rights, to a social enterprise model and onto the international stage, the Eden Social Welfare Foundation now has 80 service stations in Taiwan, with 1,800 employees, among whom one-sixth are physically or mentally disabled, and almost one-third are middle age re-employee. We serve over 8,000 dysfunctional families whose economic and marriage situation are threatened by the physical disability of the family members.

The baton of Ms. Liu Hsia is now in our hand. It is now, for us to help the needy to stand taller, walk braver and to love wiser, in this garden of Eden.

Current Outgoing Programme:

• 24hours In-house Home for disabled adults

We have about 250 people with disabilities who live in our 24hours Home as they are unable to take care of themselves due to their disabilities or family financial difficulties.

Day-time Early childhood rehabilitation

We provide early childhood assessment, consultation, rehabilitation, research and etc for the developmental-challenged children.

• Enrichment project for all ages

Home visitation, story-telling, tuition, outings, accessible tourism in Asia, and international disabled artist exchanges are conducted all year-round.

• Career counseling, vocational training and employment services for disabled adults

People with acquired disabilities can receive career counseling, rehabilitation, assessment, vocational training, job-referral and etc from Eden to help them return into the working-society.

Consultation and counseling service

Our family counseling, cultural class, translation, employment counseling, resources referral, emergency aids and etc serve those who call at our centers or referred by the government.

• Love without borders- wheelchair and white cane donation

We conduct evaluation to ensure genuine needs of wheelchair or white cane, access the suitability of device, and deliver them to the disabilities locally and internationally.

Post-disaster relief assistant and career training

We enhance education and vocation training for persons with disabilities acquired from the earthquake in Haiti and Si Chun. We also provide tuition and career counseling to those who suffered from the Morakot flood in Taiwan.

Inbound and Outbound International Volunteer Services

Volunteers are the backbone of our Foundation. From a database of more than 13,000, they volunteer their times and effort to assist Eden in administration, services, teaching, activities, marketing and other professional services both nationally and internationally.

Advocacies of rights related to people with dishabilles

Other than the above programmes, Eden always believes in constant improvement to our society. Hence, we advocate news initiatives, philanthropic needs, human rights, banning of landmines, accessible environments, etc. We continue to work towards our vision: Wherever there is a need, there is an answer from Eden.
