This NGO day-care center offers meals and diverse educational activities at no cost for 60 children in order for their extremely poor families to work and/or seek familial sustenance.

PROJECT NAME: VOLUNTÁRIOS FAZENDO CRIANÇA SORRIR! (VOLUNTEERS MAKING CHILDREN SMILE)

THE PROJECT IS SEEKING SUPPORT FOR THREE MEALS AND ONE SNACK A DAY. THIS REQUEST IS TO COVER THE COST OF PERISHABLE FOODSTUFFS FOR THE CRECHE.

THE DEMOGRAPHICS ON THE PEOPLE OF THIS AREA:

ISLA DE GOVERNADOR IS A SUBURB OF RIO DE JANEIRO- A SHANTYTOWN SLUM INHABITED BY NEARLY 10,000 FAMILIES A MAJORITY OF WHICH ARE SINGLE PARENT HOMES. THERE ARE NO NEARBY SCHOOLS OR HEALTH CENTERS AND THIS CRECHE IS THE ONLY POINT OF REFERENCE OFFERING SOCIAL SERVICES TO THIS COMMUNITY. VERY FEW FAMILIES HAVE ACCESS TO RUNNING WATER AND MOST ADULTS SCAVENGE TRASH FOR FOOD AND ITEMS TO SELL. MANY MOTHERS WORK IN THE INFORMAL LABOR MARKET AS MAIDS WHERE THEY TRAVEL UP TO 2 HOURS TO ARRIVE AT THEIR JOB OR THEY LIVE WITH THE FAMILIES FOR WHICH THEY WORK COMING HOME ONLY 2 DAYS A MONTH AND OFTEN LEAVINGTHE CARE OF THEIR OWN CHILDREN TO FAMILY OR NEIGHBORS.

MANY CHILDREN ARE INVOLVED WITH THE DRUG TRAFFICKING AND THE AREA HAS RECENTLY HAD MANY CHILDREN KILLED EITHER THROUGH RIVAL TRAFFICKING VIOLENCE OR AS A CONSEQUENCE OF POLICE RAIDS. TRAFFICKERS RECRUIT CHILDREN AS YOUNG AS 8 YEARS OLD INTO LOWER LEVEL POSITIONS SUCH AS LOOKOUTS. THE GOOD MAJORITY OFTHE POPULATION IS ILLITERATE AND THE AVERAGE EDUCATION IS 4 YEARS OF SCHOOLING. MANY CHILDREN WORK IN EITHER THE INFORMAL TRANSPORTATION MARKET OF WAIT OUTSIDE GROCERY STORES AND OFFER TO CARRY GROCERIES FOR CHANGE OR JUST PLAIN BEG FOR MONEY.

THE PROJECT WAS RECOMMENDED TO DREAMS CAN BE FOUNDATION THROUGH A BRAZILIAN PARTNER ORGANIZATIONED CALLED FASE WHO HAS LAUNCHED A CAMPAIGN ALONG WITH ONE OF BRAZIL'S LARGEST ROCK BANDS (O RAPPA) TO BRING FOOD DONATIONS TO THIS PROJECT.

### **Project summary (200)**

This NGO day-care center offers meals and diverse educational activities at no cost for 60 children in order for their extremely poor families to work and/or seek familial sustenance.

### • Project need and beneficiaries (500)

Daycare for 42 kids: 4 months to 7 years old & 18 teenagers, whose mothers abandoned by husbands, are the only source of income for family, and earn income collecting paper and cans in the street. Most have 5 children and have nowhere to leave their children while they try to make money. The needs are many, but we prioritize the food and the acquisition of kitchen appliances. The daycare depends on daily donations of food for the children.

#### • Project activities (250)

Daycare 42 kids from 4 months to 7 years old and 18 teenagers, whose mothers were abandoned by husbands and they are the only source of income for family and who are underemployed through collecting paper and cans in the street. Most of the mom's have 5 children and suffer this because they have nowhere to leave their children while they try to make money. The needs are many, but we prioritize the food and the acquisition of kitchen appliances. The daycare depends on daily donations of food for the children. Many children who remain unsupervised become involved with the trafficking in order to eat

Providing meals, recreation, early childhood learning, theatre, play area with books, social, medical and psychological assistance, tutoring, IT skills, & sports for children who would otherwise be left unattended or could become delinquent.
