

Mid-Ohio Valley Fellowship Home offers a residential program to adults ages 18 years and older, that are recovering from drug addiction and/or alcoholism. Our mission is: "To provide a safe, supportive, nurturing environment for people suffering from alcoholism or other chemical addictions. To allow sufficient time to overcome withdrawal, develop a personal recovery program, and plan for re-entry into community, work, and family."

Our program is staffed 24 hours, seven days weekly. We have five homes where men, women and women with their dependent children reside. We are a Residential program that assists recovering substance abuse individuals with: housing, healthcare, parenting, employment and sober living skills for long-term recovery.

Our program focuses on skill building in daily living, such as fiscal responsibility, wellness, education, literacy, & parenting skills. We assist family, friends, employers and community in coping with addiction. We serve as a source of education, information and referral for communities.

Our residents are individuals that struggle with sobriety and need further structure to assist them with their efforts and risk fatality without these services. We serve all counties within the state of West Virginia, as well as other outlying states.

Our residential program has been the start of a new life for thousands of men since our doors first opened in 1971. We provide 24/7 staff support, daily 12-step meetings and community support services for twelve chemically dependent men, 18 years of age or older. Residents develop good health and work habits and live cooperatively with one another. Men & Women in recovery from drugs and/or alcohol, with or without their dependent children, enter our program to gain necessary tools to lead a sober, productive and healthy life.

As an extension of our residential program, long-term residency of up to two years is available for men & women who continue to need a supportive living environment in our extended living program. By living with fellow alumni, residents in our extended housing program live with their own support group, thereby reducing the risk of relapse over the long term.

Mid-Ohio Valley Fellowship Home, Inc. is a place to begin a new life. We have been in this community since 1971. We provide our residents with an environment that inspires change. We offer a safe, sober, supportive home and surround them with caring individuals who themselves are true testimony to the benefits of living a healthy lifestyle. Most important, our facility is a place where people learn to trust themselves again; where the transition from treatment to independence takes place almost effortlessly; where long-term recovery is not just a goal...it's a way of life.
