RELATIONSHIP GUIDES- BENEFICIARIES

Beneficiaries and guides have an excellent relationship, beneficiaries are very confident with guides so guides know very near everything about them.

Felix started attending a Cuisine School, in which he will graduate in three years as a gourmet. He is really happy. It is a demanding and difficult school, guides know it so they are supporting him very closely. He is showing a lot of interest to go on with the activities and that is very important. He has always been an excellent student, and this year he had three subjects with low marks! At first he couldn't believe it but then he noticed that it is a common fact because this school is more demanding than other ones, so he knows he has to put a little more effort.

Guides also noticed it has been difficult for older beneficiaries, who are now teenagers (Yanina, Nicolás, Rafael and Joana) to fit in the secondary school, so they are looking for the way to help them. What is difficult for them is to understand texts, so Belén is bringing them books to read and practice.

A week ago Rafael started working for a t-shirts factory. This factory is near Belen's house so she always visits him there.

Beneficiaries are attending weekly meetings in which they do their homework, talk and spend Saturday afternoons together with their guides. All of them are given the tools and material for school as posters, tempera, brushes, maps, etc, and they also have photocopies of what they need.

We think it is very important to highlight the fact that in Bariloche, they have reached the closest relationship among guides and beneficiaries.

VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES

Viviana worked as a volunteer by giving school support lessons to primary school children, and Karina, as last year, worked as volunteer engaging young children in recreational activities.

This is a subject in which we still have to work hard. Together with Proniño and a new volunteer, we are trying to fulfill the plan for everyone to continue with the volunteer activities in the second half of the year.

GENERAL OVERVIEWS


Academic performance was good in Bariloche. However, we owe an explanation for those kids who have left the program: In the last report Griselda and María José showed a low performance at school. Sadly, although they had all the support from their guides, they did not pass the school year so they are now out of the program. Miguelina Rial, moved with her family to Villa la Angostura so she is also out of the program.

It is also very sad the news about Lizet, who has not the attendance enough to continue school this year; she was given a second chance at school but she did not attend school anyway, and she never told her guide about this, she hid herself, she didn't give answers about this, she never attended her support lessons, and it was considered at school that it would be a good lesson for her to let her out. It is a pity, she is acting that way because of her father's death last year and the lack of family support in her house. Her mother didn't know about this problem and didn't show much interest about it, but when the coordinator gave a pair of shoes to each of her children she complained about Felix' shoes because it were gourmet's shoes. Although Lizet is not part of the program any more, guides will continue giving her their support, because they consider it is exactly what she is in her own way, asking for. Instead of her, Angel will take her place in the program, he is a new beneficiary that the Principal at school proposed. He needed the grant because he didn't have the material enough to attend school.

Coordinators, beneficiaries and guides had a meeting the Saturday before the school classes started. Children were given the material and tools they needed to start school. Every Saturday they meet in the office in order to do the shopping according to each one's needs. We have realized that Felix needs much more material than other children, and that's because he attends a cuisine school so the material he needs is more.
