

Outreach of the International Training Program in Latin America and Caribbean countries:

COANIQUEM's holistic approach has been implemented in 20 countries. Up to date, **315 professionals** and technicians have been trained in the rehabilitation of children burns and have implemented the model of care in burn centers in their own countries. As a result, almost 120,000 children have been benefited by the International Training Program of COANIQUEM.

International Prevention Campaign

In seven countries of the region, staff members of COANIQUEM, trained 738 professionals of health centers and elementary schools to promote the prevention of children burns.

Prevention without Limits

COANIQUEM conducted during 2013 -2014 an international prevention campaign in Costa Rica, El Salvador, Dominican Republic and Guatemala sponsored by UNDP. The program trained ten professionals in each country with an E-learning course and on-site technical support.

Objectives:

Train 40 professionals in prevention.
Diagnosis of the situation in each country and design of communication strategies and prevention campaigns.
