

## **FUTURE IMPACT METRICS**

We are prepared to collect and report the following metrics:

- Number of Children Treated: Every child treated represents a life transformed.
- Number of Healthcare Professionals Trained: Each professional we train amplifies our impact, extending expert care across Latin America.
- Number of Data Entries in the Burn Registry: Each entry informs public policy, turning every burn injury into a step towards prevention.



### **PROBLEM**

Every 5 seconds, a burn injury occurs that requires medical treatment. In the US, 486,000 cases are treated annually. However, due to limited access to quality burn care and rehabilitation, the number of cases in Latin America is believed to be in the millions. Without intervention, these children face physical and emotional suffering, with lasting impacts on their quality of life and role in society.

### SOLUTION

We heal burn victims holistically, from physical wounds to emotional scars. Our programs aim to reduce the physical, emotional, and societal impacts of burn injuries. We sponsor children's treatment, train local burn professionals, and collect data to inform public policy. By doing this we transform burn injuries at personal, local, and regional levels.

## FUNDING NEEDED

Your contribution can lead the journey of transformation for burn victims:

- \$4,000 provides 1 child burn victim with comprehensive treatment for a year, giving them a chance to heal and thrive.
- \$5,000 equips 1 local health professional with the necessary training, enhancing our capacity to help more children.
- \$80,000 sustains the annual operation of the RELAQ Burn Registry, driving data-driven decisions that impact public policy.

### **PROBLEM**

Our **Sponsor a Child program** aims to alleviate the suffering of these children by supporting the comprehensive, evidence-based rehabilitation in Chile. We ensure access to quality medical treatment, psychological support, and specialized rehabilitation services. Our goal is to help every child achieve full reintegration into society.

### **FUNDING NEEDED**

The total cost to sponsor one child for a year is US\$ 5,000, considering clinical wages, travel and lodging within Latin America, medical supplies, utilities, and general expenses.

We aim at treating 50 severely burned children from Latin America every year. We only need your help to make this possible.
