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## Our Commitment

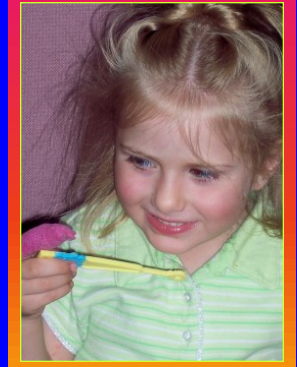

**Speech/Language Therapy**  
Speech/language therapy services address expressive and receptive language abilities, including verbal and non-verbal skills, and can include the use of adaptive system to encourage independent communication.



**Physical Therapy**  
Physical therapy works on gross motor skills such as sitting up, crawling, and walking. PT can also include equipment prescription and fitting (wheelchairs, walkers, gait trainers, braces,



## **Occupational Therapy**

Occupational therapy involves activities to promote fine motor skills (writing, coloring, and cutting), visual skills, sensory processing, and skills for independence such as self-feeding and dressing.

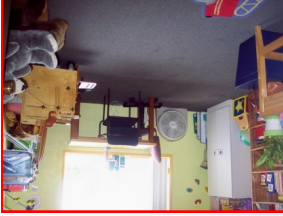


## *Our Services*
