



# Starting a WAVE of Education

## Let's Rally for the Future and build a local HIGH SCHOOL

For the majority of youth in our community obtaining a high school education is often out of reach. The only option is to travel ninety minutes each way on the public bus system for daily classes to the city or to attend classes once week on Sundays at the local elementary school. Currently over 200 students from our community attend the Sunday program.

In partnership with *Surf for Life* and the local Ministry of Education, Waves of Hope will begin construction of the high school in November 2012. The new school will provide:

- a government accredited 5-year high school education program
- a computer lab and training center
- a library and resource center
- vocational training programs
- EFL classes for children, youth & adults
- a greenhouse and organic agricultural training center
- a venue for community meetings and events

We continue to seek support in funding, resources and materials, and we invite you to contact us if you are interested in getting involved.
