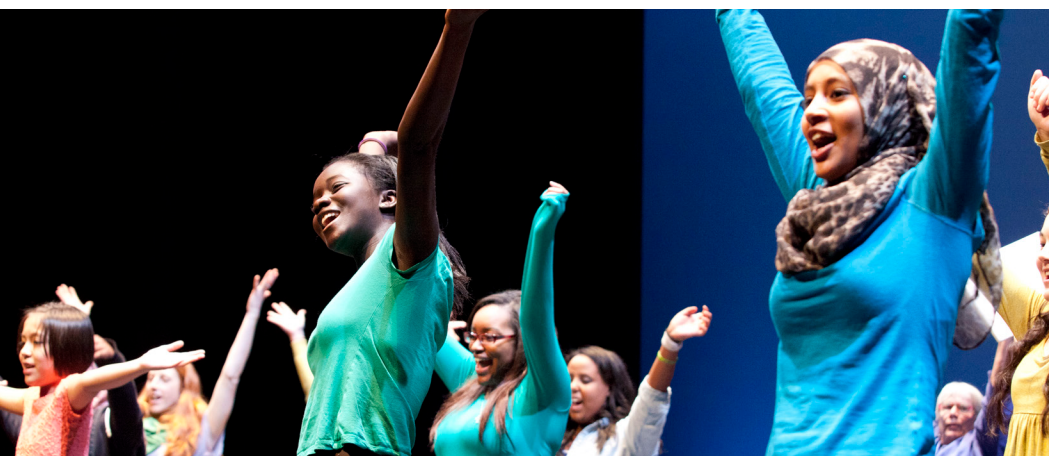

About Y-WE Mentors: The camp will have a 1:2 ration of adults to youth. Our mentors are diverse and powerful women who generously volunteer their time to participate in the camp along side the girls. Our mentors offer their skills, networks, and passions to support the success of all the young women. They are in fields that range from the arts, to business, to technology, to education.

About Hedgebrook: For over 25 years Hedgebrook has been devoted to supporting women in bringing their voices out into the world. Some of the world's most influential women authors, poets, playwrights and musicians have created work at Hedgebrook's retreat center on Whidbey Island. Hedgebrook will be selecting 4 of their powerful alumnae to work closely with Y-WE youth and mentors over the course of the camp.
