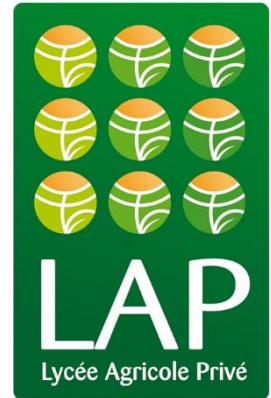


# LAP Report June 2015
