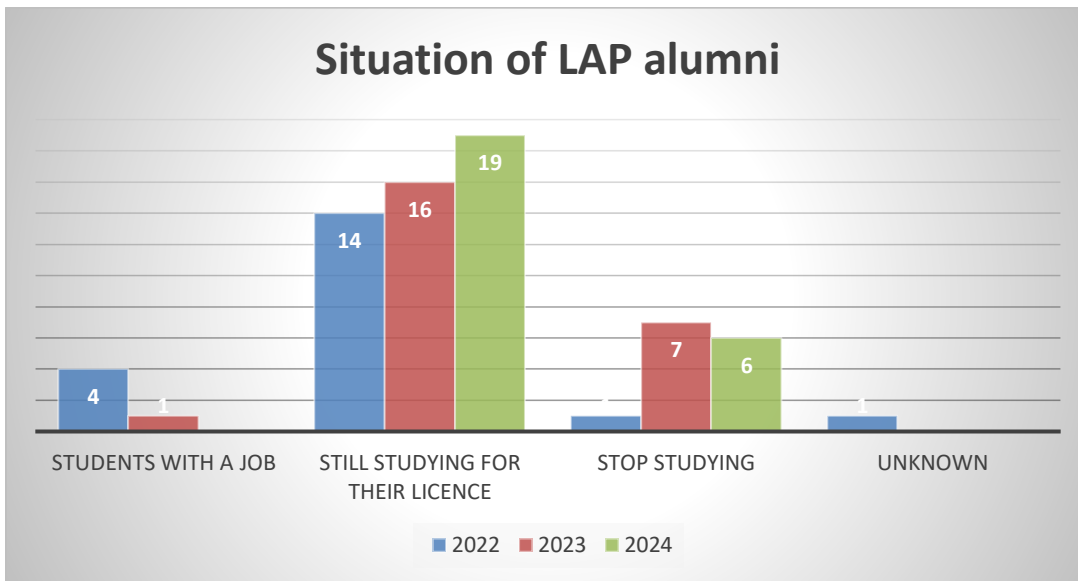


## Situation of alumni from the LAP August 2025
