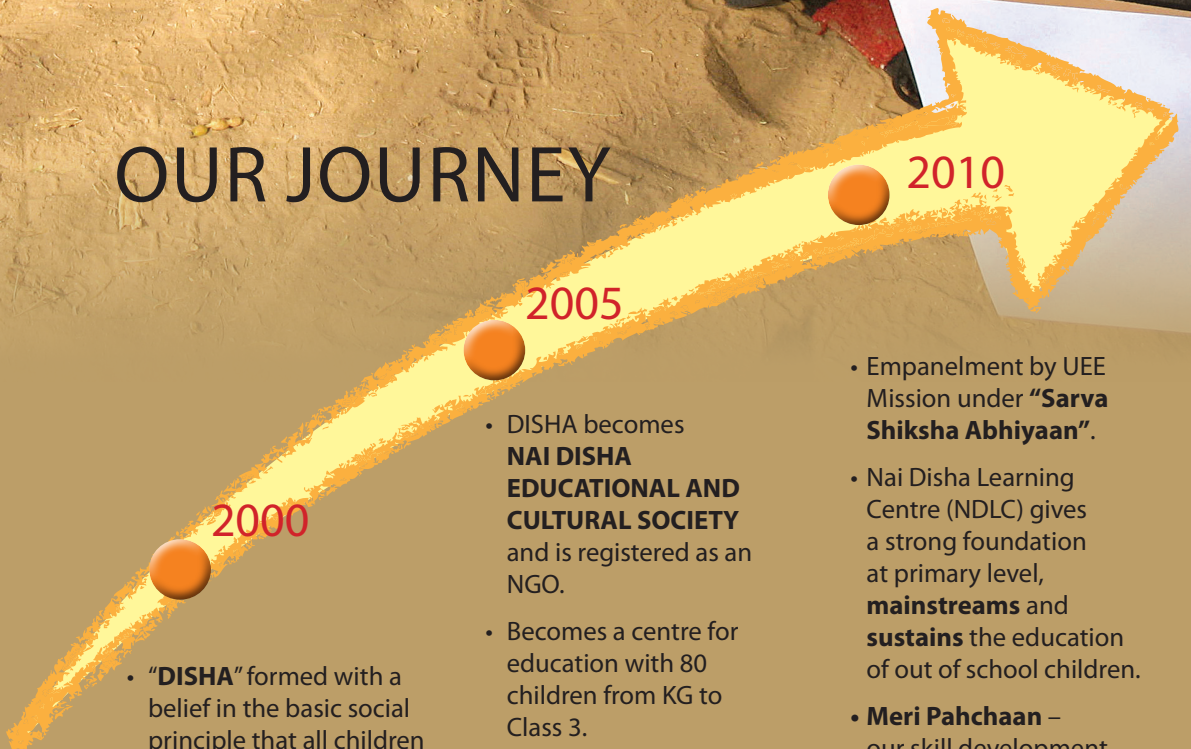


MISSION

OUR JOURNEY



2000

- "DISHA" formed with a belief in the basic social principle that all children should have quality education irrespective of their social status.
- With 12 children, books, stationery and a mid-day meal, a playschool was started.

2005

- DISHA becomes **NAI DISHA EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL SOCIETY** and is registered as an NGO.
- Becomes a centre for education with 80 children from KG to Class 3.

2010

- Empanelment by UEE Mission under "**Sarva Shiksha Abhiyaan**".
- Nai Disha Learning Centre (NDLC) gives a strong foundation at primary level, **mainstreams** and **sustains** the education of out of school children.
- **Meri Pahchaan** – our skill development programme to make children self reliant.



PROGRAMS & ACTIVITIES

Education for the needy

- Primary education for out-of-school children.
- The centre provides free remedial classes to children who have been maintreamed.
- Prepares out-of-school children (14-18 years) to complete their education from National Institute of Open School (NIOS).

Skill Development Programme

- **Meri Pehchaan** provides children in the age group of 14-18 years and young women with necessary skills to make them self-reliant.
- Computer Education- Spoken English and Personality Development.
- Creative Arts - They are taught to make items like keychains, cards and thread bangles etc.

Community Development

- Workshops for children and parents to make them aware of their legal rights and government schemes.
- Regular health camps for the children and the community.
- **The importance of imparting education to girls is emphasized.**
