The Story

Serving the Poorest of the Poor

St. Paul's Episcopal School is in one of the poorest and most remote areas of Haiti, where virtually all are desperately poor. In 1996, Colorado Haiti Project pioneer Marti O'Dell and Father Octave La Fontant began a fundraising drive among St. Paul's Parish friends and supporters in Colorado to start a primary school. Over time the school grew from serving students in three or four outdoor classrooms to the construction of a two-story school building.

A Step Up

Each year the school continues to expand, now serving students from preschool through 10th grade. This year we will provide scholarships for nearly 700 children attending the school. It is quality education that helps a child up the bottom few rungs of the ladder they need to climb to make their way in life.

A Quality Education

A kindergarten class is highly sought after, and is quite a step up from pre-school. It involves more licensing & training for the teachers, & the learning materials are costlier. Same is true for the higher grades, especially what we'd consider middle-and-high school. Teachers must be trained well, and incentivized to stay in a rural area during the school year.

Together we help sustain a welcoming environment, where hope for a better life is real, because access to a good education is real.
