OUR MISSION

PEAC is a non-profit, volunteer organization dedicated to educating current and potential bird owners about the proper care of pet birds. Unwanted and found parrots are accepted at PEAC and are adopted to qualified applicants.

FOSTER PARENT VOLUNTEERS

PEAC is not an actual “center,” but a network of specially-trained volunteers who care for foster birds in their homes, treating each bird as their very own. PEAC is not a sanctuary and only accepts “pet quality” parrots – those that are likely to be successful in an adoptive home. Each bird is evaluated for behavior issues and these are modified through patience and positive reinforcement. Our goal is to maximize each bird’s pet potential, recognizing that parrots are undomesticated pets and expecting them to be otherwise is unrealistic.

ADOPTION

All potential adopters are required to attend the *Avian Basic Care* seminar. Additionally, potential adopters of Conures and larger birds are required to attend the *Parrot Behavior and Enrichment for Parrots* seminars.

Potential adopters must have an approved adoption application on file. Adoption applications are made available to interested persons after completing the required seminars.

A home interview is required to ensure a safe environment for adopted birds. An adopter is required to reimburse PEAC for a bird’s vet expenses (up to \$200) in addition to a non-refundable adoption fee as follows:

Small Conures, Lories	\$50
Conures, Poicephalus, Senegals, Caiques	\$100
Mini-Macaws, Greys, Pionus, Amazons, Eclectus	\$150
Larger Macaws, Cockatoos	\$175
Rare species	\$200
