Now that I have been made a “credit champion” in Ogoloma with N75,000 I will use the small room at the front of my building as a store to sell different articles/goods and of course my firewood business will go on”. I am currently training one of my grand children and we are eating well”.



Champ 2 (*Ele Community*)
