AAS Burkina, through an approach focused on the family for the empowerment of vulnerable families in the context of HIV/AIDS in Ouagadougou. This program of AAS, upstream of the grant of the costs of health, education and nutrition, grants a background to families, through a savings account opened in their name, to carry out income-generating activities (AGR). Then, AAS strengthens the capacity of management of families through close monitoring. Tracking the movements in the savings book is an essential element of the AGR rating.
