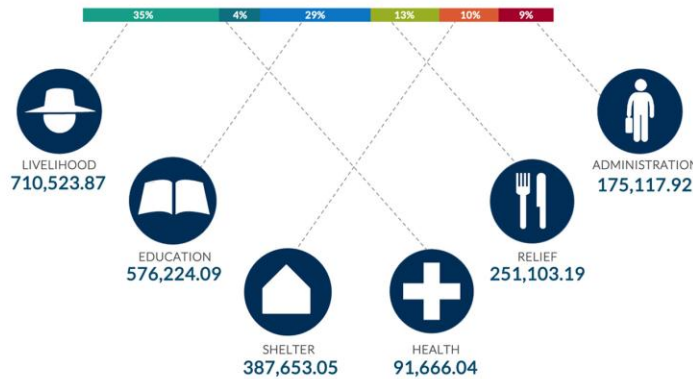

## SHELTER
