Girls Leading Our World Leadership Academy /GLOW/ offers young females, between the ages of 14 to 18 the opportunity to experience and share in a weeklong leadership academy where they build confidence and leadership skills.



It's main goal is to empower young women by giving them the social skills needed to break through the psychological barrier of our man dominated society.

GLOW retains the traditional ethos instilled by the Peace Corps volunteers focusing on encouraging the girls to think beyond the traditional limitations which our society still has.
