It has been two months since our visit to Taylor-sensei's warm and beautiful home country.


We hope you and your family are doing well.

They are searching the way to make the most of their wonderful experience and share it with others.

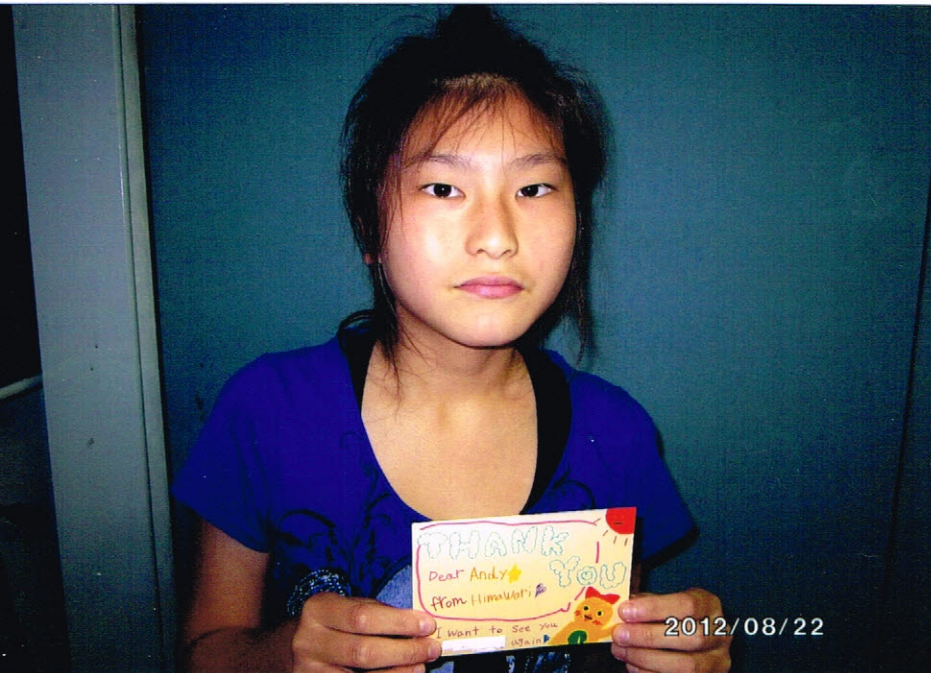
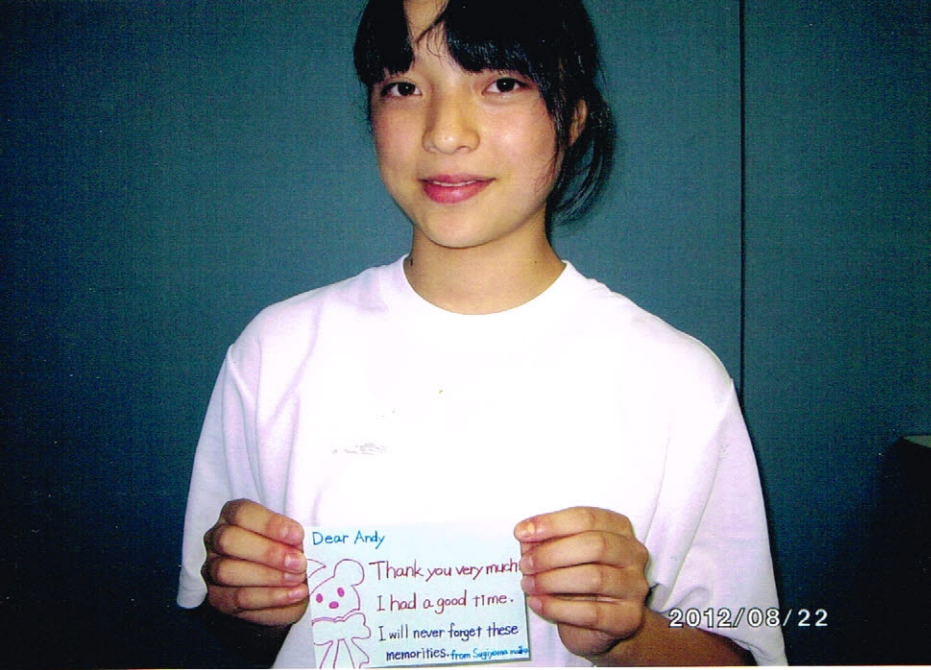
