

Training Leaders for Tomorrow - Young Leaders Camp



Our project believes in the importance of building up leadership skills in the younger generation as part of our youth development program. It was with this in mind that we organized a large-scale, intensive 4-days leadership training camp.



The camp's theme was "Simple Living, Contented Lives". The objective of the camp was to allow youths to receive multi-faceted training and experience back-to-basics living so that they would appreciate what they have. In the process they also learnt the importance of self-contentment.



This intensive leadership training was run as three concurrent camps, one for the junior girls, one for the senior girls and one for the boys. A total of 250 girls and boys participated in the camp which was held in Chaipitit Campsite in Saraburi, Thailand.



This camp like many other camps included adventure activities like white-water rafting and kayaking but these youths were also taught the importance of caring for the environment through a tree-planting activity. On top of that they also learnt the concept of servant leadership when the girls sewed soap bags and the boys hand made toys to give to less privileged children.

The camp was a huge success. These youths not only enjoyed themselves but brought home with them many valuable lessons and friendships that they had forged during the camp. Plans for the next training camp are already in the pipe line. We hope to sponsor even more underprivileged youths to be part of the next camp.
