This fall, Dragonfly Forest asked one of our longtime campers, Torey Anderson, to interview her mother, Susan Varner. Torey has attended Dragonfly's autism and asthma sessions over the past four years. Here is Torey's interview with her mother.



Torey: What was I like before I went to Dragonfly?

Susan: You weren't as vocal as you are now. When you went to Dragonfly, it just took you out of this shell that you were in. You were quiet. You kept to yourself. You didn't like people. You shut down. You didn't really like to talk to a lot of people but after that first summer of Dragonfly, it just opened you up. You were a whole new girl. You weren't shy anymore. You were outgoing. You were proud of yourself. You actually went on stage, which is something you never ever did before.

Torey: I remember that moment. It was so hard for me to do that.

Susan: Dragonfly helped you do that!

Torey: And now I love performing!

Susan: It's all Dragonfly's fault that you're the diva that you are today.

Torey: (in a diva voice) I am not a diva! That is rude!



Torey: Why was I hating everyone? Do you know why?

Susan: I don't really have an answer. When you were two years old, you were diagnosed with autism and sometimes children with autism don't like to be around big crowds, they don't like to talk to people. When you entered Dragonfly, it helped you.

Torey: I still get flustered sometimes and I still get claustrophobic but I love camp and it makes me so happy and when I go there I'm like at home. A second home.



Torey: What has the Dragonfly Forest community meant to you?

Susan: It's meant a lot. Dragonfly isn't a camp anymore, it's like a family.

Torey: Our home!

Susan: When we go there, we feel comfortable. We feel at home. We feel really close with all of the employees. They are like family to us - absolutely. They've given us opportunities that we've never dreamed of, that's for sure.

Torey: How does this week of camp affect the rest of our year?

Susan: We talk about Dragonfly everyday. We eat, sleep, and breathe Dragonfly. Every day we're talking about something that happened at camp. Dragonfly is with us all the time.

Torey: What is your favorite part about Dragonfly Forest? I like a lot of things!

Susan: It's hard to narrow down to just one thing. Dragonfly Forest allows [kids] to express themselves and be who they are and not be judged by society. The world is so cruel...[people] say so many negative things about people. Dragonfly, you don't feel like that. You don't feel like people are talking about you behind your back or saying anything bad about you. You can be you.



Torey: So my favorite part is I like the food, obviously. I like the zip lines, I also like friends. And the counselors are all nice and friendly. I like swimming. I like the staff and nurses in the getaway. Everything is fabulous. The beds are comfy.

To the families of Dragonfly who aren't sure they're going to send their kids to camp: I think you should because it will help your child embrace their inner wings and will make them soar. That's like what it did for me and that's what it did to a lot of other kids and honestly I think Dragonfly is the best camp ever!

LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Summer camp changes my life every year, even though I'm now 36 years old, a mother, and (usually) a professional. Camp magic is so powerful that this year I even brought my 9 month-old baby to live in a rustic cabin with me for 6 weeks because I can't stay away from camp. Or the baby.

It's the people that make the magic for me. Our campers are the bravest people I know. They face physical pain, difficulty breathing, and find life-threatening risk in activities the rest of us take for granted. On top of that, many of them are bullied at school. The magic of Dragonfly is that we address all these health concerns in the background, so kids can just be a part of this big beautiful camp family that loves them for who they are.

Our camp family is diverse from our youngest camper to our oldest counselor. There is no other place in my life that I can collaborate with an adult on the autism spectrum and an adult with sickle cell disease to teach a child with 22q how to navigate complex friendships or how to build a campfire. The fact that we might be wearing weird costumes or singing songs while we do this important work just makes the whole project so irresistible to me.

2016 was an exciting year for Dragonfly! We moved camp to YMCA Camp Speers in the Poconos where our campers got to swim, boat, climb, and ride horses. The facility is gorgeous and the YMCA staff are incredible. We added Mark Manning (Development Director) to our team and our program continues to grow.

My co-executive director Scott Arizala and I want to say thank you. Thank you for being part of our camp family. Thank you for standing up for kids who need it. Thank you for helping to bring joy to campers each year.

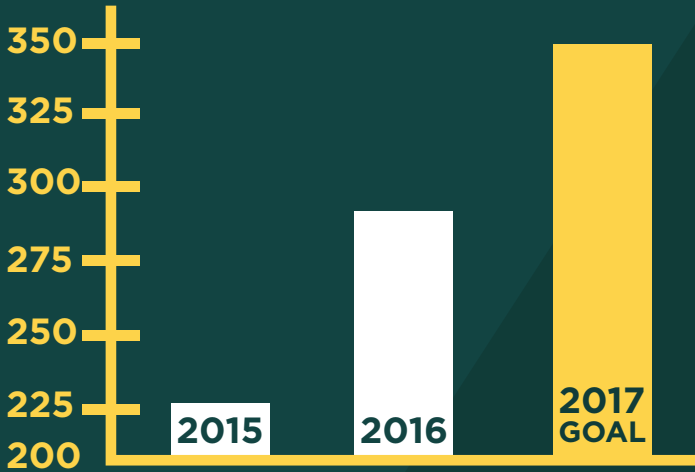

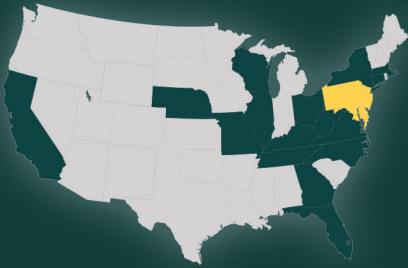
