'Karma Yogini' Vijayatai Lawate had a dream of providing a shelter to HIV (AIDS) affected women and orphaned boys and girls, - a place they could truly feel at home. This dream became a reality with Manavya's pivotal project, 'Gokul' through which women and children were offered a place filled with love and affection and where they could live with dignity and respect. With Gokul, these affected women and children who would have otherwise lived a life of despair, found a warm and loving home and life-long support.

Manavya's 'Gokul' project offers medical treatment, education and excellent care to HIV (AIDS) affected children. We at Manavya are proud that as 'Manavya'- organization founded by Vijayatai Lawate- is one of the first organizations working for HIV (AIDS) affected children.

Conquering all odds and adversities, Manavya's Gokul is bustling in a happy and enthusiastic atmosphere. Today, the organization is poised for a new quest. Due to research, improved drugs and treatments life span and health conditions of the children has improved. This has made them confident and ready to face the realities. The women and children living at Manavya, with a hope of living a normal life today stand confidently and happily, and are entering in the mainstream society because of your co-operation, and patronage of Vijayatai's dream is going towards fruition.

GOKUL

Gokul is a orphanage for over fifty children, has a hospital with a facility of four beds keeping in mind the emergency treatment that could be required (also facilitating to people living in nearby areas), library, primary school, business centre, and contact office. Gokul runs new and innovative projects responding to the call of changing times.

VANITA / KISHOR

Rehabilitation and economic independence of the children of Manavya is one of the prime concerns of the organisation. So boys above 18 (kishor) and girls above 18 (Vanita) are trained under the scheme 'earn and learn'. This project is designed in a way in which children work in the organization for two hours, work part-time and complete their vocational training with the money earned this way. This helps in boosting their confidence to live in mainstream society.

UNNATI

This project was started for students above 18 who have graduated from Gokul. Manavya always considered it their responsibility to rehabilitate students who had now entered mainstream society. Regular counselling is conducted on every last Saturday of the month as well as life's necessities like medicines, supplementary food items and financial assistance like school fees are provided.

NAVANKUR

This project offers a loving and warm home to the newborn babies of those who have now left Manavya, married and raising their own families. Young mothers receive the same affection and care as in their parents' homes.

UMED

Manavya runs an outreach program mobile clinic with its Ambulance making a four day a week visit to the nearby villages and two slums in Pune City to treat patients. Specialist Doctors are invited and tests and treatment is given to the patients. Medicines too are made available free of cost.

MATRIMONIAL GET TOGETHER

To commemorate Vijayatai's death anniversary, every year in February Manavya arranges meetings of prospective brides and bridegrooms (HIV affected) in co-operation with Rotary Club and NMP+. This program sees its success in number of happy and successful marriages.

Through these projects Manavya is committed to guide its children from darkness to light and to successfully bring HIV affected people back into mainstream society.
