The Palm Institute of Strategic Leadership (PISL) is supported by NAPE Foundation since PISL's inception in 2012. The purpose of the institute is to "Raise the Next Generation of Strategic Leaders." We are passionate about providing our students with leadership and critical thinking skills while simultaneously promoting and teaching African-centric ethics and values. We currently offer 2-year NABPTEX certified diploma courses in the following subjects:

- Business Administration
- Computerized Accounting
- Banking Technology & Accounting

These courses will contain the relevant classes but will also contain a mandatory 8-week internship that we organize for students. We are committed to providing all the necessary resources to our students to enable them to succeed both inside and outside the classroom. As well as the internship program, students have access to one-on-one tutoring services, a writing center, library, computer lab, and classrooms with air conditioning.
